

Non-discrimination Policy

Sandy Spring Friends School does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, national or ethnic origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity or a person's status as a qualified candidate with a disability in administration of its educational program, admission policies, financial aid program, staff hiring and other school-administered programs. However, special consideration may be given to members of The Religious Society of Friends.

Article XIV NON-DISCRIMINATION (from the Board bylaws 051711)

The School admits students of any race, color, religion, national or ethnic origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity or a person's status as a qualified candidate with a disability to all the rights and privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the School. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, national or ethnic origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity or a person's status as a qualified candidate with a disability in administration of its educational policies, admission policies, scholarship programs, staff hiring and other School administered programs. As used herein, pronouns and adjectives shall be masculine or feminine, singular or plural, as may be applicable in the particular situation.
